### What is included:

#### Athens:

- Athens International Airport meet and assist
- Taxi transfer to the apartment
- CYA accommodations July 23-28, July 30
- Breakfast provisions in the CYA apartments
- Welcome reception and dinner at CYA on July 23, 2022
- Reception at the home of Alexis and Mariella Phylactopoulos
- 3 meals in restaurants/tavernas of central Athens
- 1 meal in the CYA Dining Hall
- Culinary Tour, including a cheese and olive oil Tasting
- Public art walking tour of Athens
- Entrance fees for all the sites and museums that will be visited as a group
- Transportation to/from the CYA Academic Center for all excursions in Athens
- CYA faculty leader for all site visits, walking tours
- CYA staff assistant for the duration of the program

#### Nafplion:

- Chartered (air conditioned) bus to Argolid for July 28-30
